Modals: can and can't

Can is used to express *ability* or to say that something is *possible*.

Can't is used to say that something is *impossible* to do for us.



Positive form

SUBJECT + **CAN** + **ACTION**
He/she/it verb

Examples:

-She *can* dance ballet.

-He *can* play soccer.

-It *can* jump the tree.

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Negative form

SUBJECT + **CAN'T** + **ACTION**
He/she/it verb

Examples:

-She *can't* draw a lion.

-He *can't* swim at the beach.

-It *can't* fly in the sky.
